A special meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Silver Creek was held on Tuesday October 29th in the Board Meeting Room at 1924 Town Road, for the purpose of discussing Resolution 2024-8 for Superior Shores Liquor License.

Present: Supervisors Chuck Voss, Greg Hull and Scott Krech; Clerk Alison Oftedahl; and by phone, Deputy Clerk Katie Anderson.

Absent: None.

Visitors Present: None.

Chairman Voss called the meeting to order at 6:30p.m. and explained the purpose of the meeting was to review Resolution 2024-8 for Superior Shores Liquor License.

The group then said the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Board reviewed the application and other materials forwarded from Lake County.

Supervisor Hull asked if a liquor license is transferred with the business or property. Oftedahl and Voss reported it does not. This license was needed due to a change in the company managing Superior Shores Resort. Hull also raised concerns about the total number of liquor licenses in the Township. The group believed that there are 3 in the Township currently. After this discussion, motion Voss, and second Krech to hold a vote on Resolution 2024 (included below). Motion carried 2:1.
